- At Coral Reef Institute, we offer the following programs to help you reach your goal.

There are 3 levels of training for you to achieve:

- Level 1 includes the overview of dive theories and skills.
- Level 2 introduces advanced dive management & rescue skills.
- Level 3 follows to complete the scuba instructor training and dive leadership rank, preparing you to teach and certify scuba students either during your internship with us or real world employment.



Level 1 (duration: 1 week)

Perquisite: at least 18 years old, is healthy to participate in scuba diving, be able to swim non-stop for 200m, have basic aquatic skills in deep water.

- **Courses:** Nitrox Diver + Rescue Diver + Emergency 1st Response (CPR/First AID/AED) + Oxygen Provider
- **Ratings gain at completion:** 4 PADI certifications
- **Include:** tuition, hired dive equipment, your own PADI manuals for all of the courses, PADI Certification Cards, all training dives required to complete each course and be qualified for Level 2.

Level 2 (duration: 1-3 months)

Perquisite: in addition to Level 1, have logged 20 dives prior to starting the Divemaster Course, is cleared by a physician as healthy to participate in scuba diving.

- **Pro Courses:** PADI Divemaster + Emergency First Response Instructor + PADI Oxygen Provider Instructor
- **Ratings gain at completion:** 3 total with 2 PADI Instructor certifications
- **Include:** Tuition for all courses, your DM Crew Pak (DM manuals, Encyclopaedia of Recreational Diving & Dive Knowledge Workbook, DM slates), EFR Instructor Guide, PADI Oxygen Provider Instructor Guide.
- **Not include:** your PADI professional fees (see detailed information below)
- Begin Internship as Divemaster after certification to gain experience

Level 3 (duration: 1-2 months)

Perquisites: in addition to Level 1 & 2, have logged 60 dives prior to starting the IDC, be certified as a Divemaster, be certified as an CPR/First Aid Instructor prior to receiving teaching status.

- **Programs:** IDC Prep + Instructor Development Course (IDC) + Nitrox Instructor Course + Instructor Examination (3 days) + Master Scuba Diver Trainer Prep Program (4 additional specialties instructor training)
- **Ratings gain at completion:** 6 Instructor certifications
- **Include:** PADI Required Instructor Materials (Instructor Manual & Workbook, slates, exam booklets & specialty outlines), dive management training for boat & shore dives, core competency specialties training in Deep, Wreck, Digital Underwater photo & Navigation, Practical training & instructor internship, Employment counselling & job placement
- **Not include:** Instructor Examination fee and your PADI professional fees (see detailed information below)

PADI Professional Fees

Here are the PADI required costs that you will need to account for. In the PADI professional rank, all of the administrative processes are handled by the PADI Asia Pacific Office in Sydney, Australia. Your membership fees are to be paid (via Credit Card) directly to PADI in Australian Dollars. They are as follow:

1. Initial Membership Fee (pay to PADI after you are certified as a divemaster)
2. Instructor Examination 2010 (pay to PADI at the exam you plan to attend)
3. Instructor Application Processing Fee (pay to PADI after you complete the IDC)
4. Emergency First Response Instructor Fee (pay to PADI after you are certified)
5. Specialty Instructor Rating (pay to PADI after you are certified)
